Please be attentive to the cut off dates for submission of applications. **Families must send in completed approved taxes for 2017 to qualify.** Make sure you apply for the 2018-19 school year. Families will be notified if they have received funding late June or September. 80% of the funding is given out in June and 20% in September. Approval is based on the Archdioceses qualifications and the number of families that apply. **ONLY FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN IN GRADES K-8 MAY APPLY!**

TUITION—ALL TUITION FOR GRADES K-8 MUST BE PAID IN FULL BY APRIL 1ST AS STATED IN THE TUITION POLICY unless other arrangements were made with the Business Office. NO 8TH GRADER WILL BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE CLASS TRIP IN APRIL OR GRADUATION CEREMONY IF TUITION IS NOT PAID IN FULL
